1 An act to require bus shelters to be placed at every public school bus stop.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill is designed to provide shelters where at least 6 children wait together at the same time in
6 a day. This is only required for public schools, if the stop is at a school, the shelters will not be required.

7
8 Section 2: This bill will keep children safe from weather and provides a visual perspective for the bus drivers.
9 It will also keep any school required materials the children bring safe and protected.

10
11 Section 3: The new shelters will be installed using materials of the public school system decides on. The bus
12 stop must also have at least 6 students at one time of the day. The structure of the shelter will be chosen by
13 the school system, but it would be required to have a roof and a seating area.

14
15 Section 4: The shelters will be paid for by the board of education. If the Board of Education is not possible to
16 pay, each school will ask for an average of \$5 from each student.

17
18 Section 5: There will be an added secretary hired to go through schools and bus stops to make sure the
19 shelters are in place. This will be viewed every month.

20
21 Section 6: The first penalty will be a warning. The second penalty would be a \$50 fine to the school. If this is
22 still not implied, the buses for that school would not be available.

23
24 Section 7: The bill for bus shelters will be in effect on January 1, 2015.
