1                   An act to prohibit electronic cigarette sales to people under the age of 18.

3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Electronic cigarettes, or " e-cigarettes" are cigarette-shaped devices that release vapor to mimic  
6 actual smoking and most contain nicotine. The use of e-cigarettes by minors is increasing each year. This bill  
7 will prohibit the sale of all electronic cigarettes to minors.

9 Section 2: Electronic cigarettes should be regulated as regular cigarettes and tobacco products which are  
10 not sold to minors.

12 Section 3: This bill will not require any additional funding. It will be enforced by the authorities that already  
13 monitor and regulate the retail sales of tobacco products. Failure to abide by this law will result in the  
14 corresponding punishments as our state laws for tobacco product sales to minors.

16 Section 4: This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
