- 1                   An act to amend the Kentucky State Constitution to allow same sex marriage in Kentucky.
- 2
- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5   Section 1: This bill would allow same sex marriage in Kentucky by amending the Kentucky State Constitution.
- 6   It would be a measure to repeal Section 233 A which only validates and recognizes marriage between a man
- 7   and a woman.
- 8
- 9   Section 2: This will affect people in same sex relationships who wish to get married in Kentucky. Primarily,
- 10 this will allow same sex couples identical rights and benefits in regard to the legal status of marriage.

- 12   Section 3: The Kentucky General Assembly will vote to allow this bill and repeal the previous section 233 A.
- 13
- 14   Section 4: Upon passage, this bill will go into effect on January 1, 2014.
