1 An act to require all school faculty to be certified in CPR.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section I: This bill will require all Kentucky school faculty and staff members to be  
6 trained and certified in CPR.

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8 Section II: All faculty and staff members must have a minimum of six credited and  
9 required hours of proper CPR training. Along with CPR instruction, the  
10 instruction will include the proper administration of an AED and the  
11 Heimlich Maneuver.

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13 Section III: Training/Instruction will be carried out by the Certified District Nurse  
14 and/or School Health Coordinator through scheduled meetings set up by  
15 the principals of each school within the district.

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17 Section IV: Funding for this bill will be provided by each Board of Education with the  
18 funds already allocated for professional development trainings for all faculty and staff  
19 members within the district.

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22 Section V: Non-compliance by any faculty and staff member within a school district  
23 shall result in the following penalties/punishments:

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25 1st Offense: Faculty/Staff member(s) will receive a written warning from the  
26 Superintendent for non-compliance and will be required to pay for  
27 and attend a training session outside of the school district.

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29 2nd Offense: Faculty/Staff member(s) will be suspended without pay until the  
30 training is completed. Since this will now be required for  
31 employment, the Superintendent has the right to fire or suspend  
32 personnel based on non-compliance with district policies.

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34 Section VI: The Superintendent of each school district in the state of Kentucky will be  
35 responsible for the enforcement of this bill.

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38 Section VII: This bill will go into effect for the 2014-2015 school year.
