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3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
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5	Section 1: Strong student teacher relationships have a direct effect on student achievement. In order to
6	foster both student teacher and student parent relationships Elementary schools will be required to
7	complete home visits on every student once per school year. These visits will allow teachers to not only build
8	relationships but also observe the students home life.
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10	Section 2: Local districts will be required to develop a plan to accomplish the requirements of this bill.
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12	Section 3: The Kentucky department of education will provide support and development opportunities to
13	help with the implementation of this bill. All school districts receiving Kentucky SEEK funding will be required
14 15	to comply.
16	Section 4: This bill will go into effect one (1) school year after the date of passage.
