1 An act to require licensed drivers to retake their written driver's test.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: All licensed drivers will be required to take the written driver's test every eight years during the  
6 renewal process.

7  
8 Section 2: Written exam dates and times vary by county, but are administered at local courthouses or judicial  
9 centers. Drivers seeking renewal must check testing days/times at [ketuckystatepolice.org](http://ketuckystatepolice.org). The Kentucky  
10 State Driving Manual is also available at this website.

11  
12 Section 3: The common exam is a written knowledge test containing questions regarding driving rules,  
13 regulations, procedures, and highway signs. Drivers must make a minimum of 80% on this test to pass and  
14 be eligible for license renewal.

15  
16 Section 4: Drivers who do not pass may re-take the exam on the next available date offered in their county.

17  
18 Section 5: Drivers (except for active-duty military serving out of state) must renew in person pending a  
19 passing score on the written exam.

20  
21 Section 6: Renewal cost will increase from \$20 to \$21. This \$1 increase will fund the materials needed for  
22 the additional test forms and scoring.

23  
24 Section 7: All records of testing and renewal will be maintained by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)  
25 and the Kentucky Department of Transportation.

26  
27 Section 8: All repercussions from current late licensing renewal will apply.

28  
29 Section 9: This bill will go into effect in January of 2014.
