An act to require renewing drivers to take hearing and vision tests every 8 years.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Each driver in the state of Kentucky will have to take hearing and vision test every 8 years as they renew their license.

Section 2: These tests will be taken every other time the driver renews their license. A reminder will be added to the driver license renewal notice that every driver receives.

Section 3: These tests will be conducted at the DMV (Department of Motor Vehicles) by specialized employees.

Section 4: The average cost of a Welch Allyn Audio Scope is \$700 and a Snellen Eye Chart is \$5.00. The estimated cost to implement this bill is: \$705 per county.

Section 5: The funding for this bill will come from increasing the license renewal cost by \$2.00.

Section 6: For those that do not comply with taking a hearing and vision test, the first offense: \$250.00 fine plus court fees. If not renewed within 90 days, your license is suspended until the tests are taken.

Section 7: This bill will go into effect immediately after passage. Licensed drivers will have to comply with this when they go to renew their licenses the first time after passage.
