5 6 7	Section 1: Drivers driving past school bus stop signs is a big problem. Kids get injured and even killed every day. But, this can stop.
8 9 10 11	Section 2: When Maryland installed cameras on their school buses they found that 7,000 cars passed school buses when their stop signs were out each day. They now can save people by prosecuting each and every person.
