- 5 Section 1: The current laws for texting and driving in Kentucky state that the driver will be given 3 penalty
- 6 points on their license. We plan to increase the penalties for texting and driving.

- 8 Section 2: Texting and driving is defined as composing, sending, or reading text messages while operating a
- 9 motor vehicle

- 11 Section 3: The act will not cost the state any money to enforce but shall provide money for the state from
- 12 the fines collected. 25% from the fines will go to the traffic school.

- 14 Section 4: The bill shall go into effect January 1st, the year after the bill is passed.
