1                   An act to require school to be dismissed on November 1st for all public schools in Kentucky.  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: This bill proposes that all public schools in Kentucky be made to dismiss school on November 1st.  
6   Currently schools are not required to dismiss school the day after Halloween. This bill will require all  
7   Kentucky schools to close school for students on November 1st of each school year.  
8  
9   Section 2: This bill will affect all public schools in Kentucky. This will improve the learning environment and  
10   well-being of our students and minimize the risk of schools being open on a low attendance day.  
11  
12   Section 3: The consequences: Any school district not dismissing school on November 1st will suffer  
13   consequences. For the first offense, the school district will be given a warning. On the second offense, the  
14   district will be fined \$10,000. For the third offense, the district will loose state funding until proving that  
15   their district closed school on November 1st for the following school year.  
16  
17   Section 4: This bill should start July 1, 2015. This bill would not require any funding by the government  
18   through tax dollars.
