

1 2	An act to limit welfare benefits for able bodied Kentucky Citizens.
2 3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7	Section 1: Welfare benefits will be limited to two, to no more than three years for able bodied Kentucky citizens.
8 9 10	Section 2: Able bodied citizens are those who are not effected by medical, physical, and or mental disabilities.
11 12 13	Section 3: This bill pertains to Kentucky citizens who are currently receiving welfare benefits, and to those who may receive benefits in the future.
14 15	Section 4: This bill puts limits on the amount of time a recipient will receive benefits.
16 17 18 19	Section 5: In order for a person to continue to receive benefits after the 2 to 3 years limit, they must show proof that they are seeking employment and or bettering themselves by attending an academic, or trade school.
20 21 22	Section 6: This bill, if passed, will not cost Kentucky taxpayers any money, in fact, this bill will save money for the commonwealth.
23	Section 7: This bill will become effective immediately after passage.
