3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

5	Section 1: Presently in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, only nurses and coaches in public schools are
6	required to be certified in CPR and First-Aid. This bill will require all Kentucky public school teachers to be
7	certified in First-Aid and CPR.

9	Section 2: First-Aid and CPR training will enable Kentucky public school teachers to learn basic medical skills
10	that may be used in various school settings.

12	Section 3: If you apply First-Aid to an injured person the chances of him/her surviving increase greatly. This
