

1 2 3	An act to prohibit a driver from having in their lap any object which interferes with the driver's control of a vehicle.
4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

6	Section I – Many people are distracted when driving and find that their mind is on something other than the
7	road. Often, they take their eyes off the road, or their hands off the steering wheel, or worse, all three
8 9	things happen at once.
10	Section II – In 2011, 3,331 people were killed in motor vehicle crashes involving a distracted driver, and an
11	additional 387,000 people were injured. This bill to reduce distractions such as those caused by a pet riding
12	in a driver's lap, unrestrained pets moving about in the front seats of a vehicle, or the use of electronic
13	devices or other objects that divert a driver's attention from the road.
14	
15	Section III – Definition – Distracted driving is any activity that could divert a person's attention away from
16	the primary task of driving. All distractions endanger, passenger, and bystander safety.
17	
18	Section IV – Current law KRS 189.470 Obstruction to operator's view or control states:
19	(1) No person shall operate a vehicle when it is so loaded , or when there are in
20	the front seat such number of persons, exceeding three (3), as to obstruct
21	the view of the operator to the front or sides of the vehicle or as to interfere
22	with the operator's control over the vehicle.
23	(2) No passenger in a vehicle or street car shall ride in such a position as to
24	interfere with the operator's view ahead or to the sides, or to interfere with his control over the vehicle or street car.
