1 An act to require all motorcyclist in Kentucky to wear a helmet.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to keep motorcyclist safe while on the road.

7 Section 2: Currently, in 29 states, it is illegal to ride a motorcycle without a helmet. In Kentucky the law
8 states that all motorcyclists age 21 years or younger must wear a helmet. We propose to include all ages
9 because according to a report in 2012 there were 792 people involved in accidents not wearing a helmet
10 and 59 were fatal and 96 had critical injuries.

12 Section 3: This bill would make Kentucky's roads safer for all motorcyclists and save lives.

14 Section 4: The fines will be as follows:

16 First offense: \$100.00

17 Second offense: \$150.00

18 Third offense: \$200.00

19 Fourth offense: \$250.00 and license revoked

21 Section 5: The bill will go into effect 4 months after passage.
