1 An act to create outdoor adult gyms.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: This bill is designed to create outdoor adult gyms in every county in Kentucky to combat the
6 state's obesity problem.

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8 Section 2: Kentucky ranks 10th in the country in obesity. More than 30 percent of Kentuckians are obese.
9 Experts predict by the year 2030 more than 60 percent of adults are expected to be obese.

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11 Section 3: Outdoor gyms will be built in the state beginning with the counties with the highest percentage of
12 obesity.

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14 Section 4: Each county's government will determine the location of its outdoor gym. Money will be allocated
15 to each county from grants, private industry, and donations.

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17 Section 5: This bill will take effect in May, 2015.
