1	An act to require background checks at gun shows
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: People all over Kentucky are given the opportunity to buy firearms at gun shows with no
6 7	background checks. This creates the danger of allowing the wrong person to get their hands on a firearm. In order to solve this problem, our bill proposes that sellers at gun shows must background check all
8	customers. This way each person who buys a firearm will be checked and given permission by the FBI to
9	obtain a firearm.
10	
11	Section 2: Every gun seller must sign up with the FBI background check database prior to selling firearms at
12	a gun show. This can easily be done by filling out the six page ATF Form 4473. Background checks can be
13	done via the internet or the phone.
14 15	Section 3: Each person who buys a firearm from a seller at a gun show must be background checked by the
16	FBI database. This will only take a few minutes.

18	Section 4: Both private sellers and larger sellers with booths must sign up with the FBI database to sell their
19	firearms.

21	Section 5: Failure to background check a customer will result in expulsion from all future gun shows, seizure
22	of the firearm, and possible legal repercussions (including felony charges).
