An act to require all Kentucky high schools to administer the driver's permit test at school during school hours.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: All Kentucky high schools shall be required to administer the driver's permit test during school hours. A teacher will be trained by the state to administer the test one day every week during the school year. Schools will allot the first 30 minutes or the last 30 minutes of the school day to give the test.

- Section 2: The test will be administered by the Kentucky State Department of Motor Vehicles.
- Section 3: Expenses will be covered by the 4 million dollars gained each year from higher attendance rates.
- Section 4: The bill will be enforced by Kentucky State Police representatives since trained individuals will be administering the test.
- Section 5: This bill will be put into effect at the beginning of the 2014–15 school year.
