1 An act to restrict the sale of Energy Drinks to anyone under the age of 16.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: All products labeled as Energy Drinks (+9 mg of caffeine per ounce) may no longer be sold to any
6 youth under the aged of 16.

7
8 Section 2: Anyone wanting to purchase products that exceed the caffeine limit must show a valid photo ID
9 at the time of purchase.

10
11 Section 3: this bill will be enforced by local law enforcement in each county and will be funded through fines
12 from the stores fined for breaking this law.

13
14 Section 4: Any store willing to sell products that are labeled as energy drinks must have a (free) permit
15 allowing the sale of such drinks at the establishment, then submit to random undercover checks at least once
16 a month by local law enforcement to ensure the act is being followed.

17
18 Section 5: The penalties opposed unto any store attempting to sell energy drinks to minors will be as
19 follows:

20
21 1st offense: Written warning

22 2nd offense: \$50.00 fine

23 3rd offense: \$75.00 fine

24 4th offense: \$100.00 fine and banning the sale of energy drinks at the offending establishment.

26 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2014
