1 An act to allow minors age 12 and over to make their own medical decisions without parental consent.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: No parent shall deprive a minor age 12 or over, of life saving medical treatment based on
6 religious, cultural, or other personal beliefs.
7
8 Section 2: No parent shall deprive a minor age 12 or over, of life saving medical care due to inability to pay.
9
10 Section 3: No parent shall force a minor age 12 or over, to donate blood, tissue, organs, marrow, or other
11 parts of their person.
12
13 Section 4: All minors age 12 and over, shall be permitted to obtain all medications, contraceptives, and other
14 medical treatments as prescribed by a medical professional.
15
16 Section 5: This bill does not pertain to elective procedures such as abortion or plastic surgery.
17
18 Section 6: This bill does not pertain to minors age 12 or over, who suffer from debilitating emotional,
19 physical, or mental disorders that affect their cognitive ability to make decisions as deemed by a medical
20 professional.
