11 12	Section 3: The duties to be performed must be clearly specified and agreed up	oon between both parties.	
13 14 15 16	Section 4: If a person receiving these benefits is not proven unable to perform choose not to do them, their benefits will be cut accordingly based on the size cost of living.		

Section 5: A person will be proven unable to work by a committee of state employees. Reasons to be

ineligible to work can be anything from physical illness to mental illness.

Section 6: This bill will take effect one year after passage.
