- 1 An act to require individuals receiving public assistance to perform volunteer hours if not proven unable.
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Any person receiving welfare or unemployment benefits for longer than a period of six months will
- 6 be required to perform eight hours of volunteer employment a month at any state registered business to
- 7 gain work experience to help them get back into the job field.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: The state registered business must be approved by personnel at the state employment office.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: The duties to be performed must be clearly specified and agreed upon between both parties.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: If a person receiving these benefits is not proven unable to perform the service hours an they
- 14 choose not to do them, their benefits will be cut accordingly based on the size of their family and the state
- 15 cost of living.
- 16
- 17 Section 5: A person will be proven unable to work by a committee of state employees. Reasons to be
- 18 ineligible to work can be anything from physical illness to mental illness.
- 19
- 20 Section 6: This bill will take effect one year after passage.
