An act to require the recertification of all Class D Kentucky drivers every 8 years.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill requires all class D license holders in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to retake the road part of the standard Kentucky driver's test every eight (8) years in order to renew their license.

Section 2: The test will be taken at the expense of the individual taking the test. The amount of the expense will be determined by the municipality in which they reside.

Section 3: In the case that a citizen fails their road test their license will be suspended until a passing grade can be received on the test.

Section 4: After passage of this bill any currently license driver will be required to retest when their license expires in order to renew.

Section 5: Upon passage, this bill will become law on January 1st, 2015.
