1 An act to Enhance the Education of Special Needs Children

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: Definitions: "Special needs" classifies all students that present extraordinary physical or mental
6 disabilities; "special education programs" include all classes or courses designed to meet the needs of special
7 needs children; and "school choice" defines the ability for parents to choose the school within a district which
8 their children will attend.

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10 Section 2: To allow children of special needs to maintain their respective relationships with special
11 education programs and administrators, parents of special needs children are to be guaranteed the privilege
12 of school choice in all public school districts within the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

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14 Section 3: Upon passage, this act will take effect in the 2014-2015 school year.
