1 An act to limit carbon emissions in the Commonwealth of Kentucky through vehicle emissions test.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section I: This bill is designed to limit carbon emissions in the Commonwealth of Kentucky as a preemptive
6 measure to curb negative environmental effects.

7
8 Section II: Any motor vehicle licensed under the Kentucky Department of Transportation must pass an
9 emissions test in order to be registered. Vehicles may not exceed .25 grams per mile driven in emitted non-
10 methane organic gases.

12 Section III: Exceptions:

- 13 -Vehicles made in 1975 or prior
- 14 -Diesel-powered vehicles manufactured prior to 1997 (or a GVWR of more than 14,000 pounds)
- 15 -Electric vehicles
- 16 -Natural gas powered vehicles weighing more than 14,000 pounds
- 17 -Hybrids
- 18 -Motorcycles
- 19 -Trailers

21 Section IV: Every time vehicle registration is renewed, a "smog certificate".a printout of your vehicle's
22 emissions test results – must be obtained. Vehicles must be registered within 90 days of emissions
23 inspection. If a vehicle fails the smog test, you'll be unable to register it until repairs are made; the vehicle
24 must be retested, and must pass the inspection.
