1 An act to establish a Kentucky state volunteer disaster relief program.
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: A program that establishes a group of trained volunteers in every county to provide disaster clean
6 up relief in the event of a natural disaster.
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8 Section 2: The cost will be about \$18000. This cost will cover training seminars and equipment.
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10 Section 3: This program shall be headed by each Sheriff's office in each county. These duties shall be
11 included in the emergency management duties of the sheriff's office.

13 Section 4: In the case, a county sheriff refuses to enact the program, the county will be fined \$5,000 and
14 Kentucky State Police department will enact the program.
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16 Section 5: This program will go into effect on January 1, 2014.
