An act to have health care insurances pay up to 200 dollars yearly to cover the cost of a certified health club membership.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: A part of your general health care package must include up to two hundred dollars of a yearly certified health club membership. You can only qualify for this program if you are diagnosed by a certified medical professional as obese.

Section 2: Health care packages now must include a maximum of 200 dollars for individuals who have been diagnosed by a certified health professional as obese. The 200 dollars will pay for a certified health club to encourage obese individuals to participate in an exercise program. This program is an optional program.

Section 3: If health care insurances do not comply this fines system will be put in place. First offense: 500 dollar fine; two months to comply. Second offense: 1,000 dollar fine; two months to comply. Third offense: 1,500 dollar fine; two months to comply. Fourth offense: Their business license will be suspended, not allowing them to do business in Kentucky.

Section 4: Clients who are not receiving this program will notify the Kentucky Department of Insurance and they will investigate the situation.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect January 1st 2014.
