- 1 An act to abolish the paternal rights of anyone convicted of a first degree sexual assault that caused the
- 2 conception of a child.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 5
- 6 Section 1: No person convicted of a first degree sexual assault shall have custody of any child conceived
- 7 through said sexual assault.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: Anyone convicted of a first degree sexual assault who has previously received custody of a
- 10 minor(s) who was conceived through said sexual assault shall have their parental rights revoked.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: Upon revoking parental rights, the sexual offender will be required to pay child support if deemed
- 13 by the court of law.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: This will be a condition of any conviction of any first degree sexual assault.
- 16
- 17 Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1st, 2014.
