Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

conception of a child.

Section 1: No person convicted of a first degree sexual assault shall have custody of any child conceived through said sexual assault.

Section 2: Anyone convicted of a first degree sexual assault who has previously received custody of a minor(s) who was conceived through said sexual assault shall have their parental rights revoked.

Section 3: Upon revoking parental rights, the sexual offender will be required to pay child support if deemed by the court of law.

Section 4: This will be a condition of any conviction of any first degree sexual assault.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1st, 2014.
