An act to set a legal amount of foster homes required for the population of the regions of Kentucky

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Currently in Kentucky more than 6,800 children are in the Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) Foster Care. Many of these homes are over populated. This act will set a minimal number of foster homes for a set population.

Section 2: Currently for every 149 children in Kentucky, 1 is in foster care. So for every 894 children under the age of eighteen, there shall be 1 foster home operating (being that each foster home houses no more than six children at one time).

Section 3: The foster homes created by this act shall be funded by the state of Kentucky.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect 1 year after the bill is passed.
