1 An act to decrease foreign oil dependency and emissions in Kentucky.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Presently in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, oil is imported at a rate of 5.2 million gallons a week,
6 that is 249.5 million gallons of oil a year, 85% of this is imported.

8 Section 2: This bill proposes both a decrease and an increase in sales tax for all vehicles. For vehicles that
9 are more fuel efficient there will be a decrease in 2% integer until is at 0% sales tax for vehicles that get 50
10 MPG. For cars that are less fuel efficient there tax will increase by 1% integers until is at 12% for vehicles
11 that get 15 MPG. This will promote more fuel efficient cars so people won't be taxed as much.

13 Section 3: The money lost will be made up, and the money left over will be used to make improvements to
14 the roads and bridges, and install metered charging stations in government locations.

16 Section 4: This bill will go into effect July 1st of the following year it is passed.
