1 An act to create a maximum amount of children allowed in a foster home per square footage.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: Currently in Kentucky there are no stipulations on the maximum number of foster children allowed
6 in any given home. This bill limits the foster homes to only allow one child per every 600 square feet in a
7 facility.

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9 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by social workers already designated to the children by the
10 Commonwealth of Kentucky. If conditions are not as specified, the social workers are required to call the
11 Child Abuse Hotline where they will further investigate.

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13 Section 3: The administrators from the Child Abuse Hotline will then come to the home and make changes as
14 needed or go to the extent of closing the home and move the children to a different facility if seen fit.

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16 Section 4: This will go in effect January 1st, 2014.
