4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: Home schooled students in grades 6-12 will be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities
7 in public schools within their school districts.

9 Section 2: All home schooled students must meet standard school requirements, such as high school GPA.

11 Section 3: The home schooled student will have to go through the same audition/tryout process as all other
12 students.

14 Section 4: There is no cost for this bill.

15
16 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the start of the school year following passage of the bill.
