1 An act to eliminate out-of-school suspensions for non-violent offenses.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All non-violent offenses that would currently be punished by out-of-school suspensions will be
6 punished by in-school suspensions.

7
8 Section 2: During in-school suspensions, students will be placed in a designated room under the supervision
9 of a school employee where they will complete any class work they miss during their punishment. This will
10 ensure that the student can finish his or her work and will not risk falling behind or getting into more trouble
11 at home.

13 Section 3: The funding required for this bill will be the cost of providing instructional employees to monitor
14 the students and ensure that they are completing their class work. If the school already has an established
15 in-school suspension program, no additional funding will be needed for their school.

17 Section 4: A percentage of funding that a school district receives from the state will be withheld if schools do
18 not replace out-of-school suspensions with in-school suspensions.

19
20 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the next school year following its passage.
