- 1 An act to ensure fair and equal working conditions and benefits as well as employment opportunities to all
2 legal workers in the state of Kentucky.
3
- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
- 6 Section 1: This bill proposes to provide the equal employment opportunities equal pay, work benefits, and
7 safe working conditions regardless of age disability or sexual orientation.
8
- 9 Section 2: Companies can decide what benefits and pay to offer different positions but must offer them to
10 all workers for that position.
11
- 12 Section 3: Companies may base employment upon achievement from previous jobs, in the community or in
13 school.
14
- 15 Section 4: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
