

1 2	An act to institute a golf cart licensing system in Kentucky.
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4 5 6	Section 1: All golf cart owners will be required to have a permit to drive the vehicle on public roads.
6 7 8 9	Section 2: The Kentucky Department of Transportation will create an on-line permit agency site that will handle all permit applications.
10 11 12	Section 3: A safety course/exam will be administered through this site for all golf cart owners/drivers seeking permit status. Applicants must make a minimum of 80% on this test to pass and be eligible for permit status.
13 14 15 16	Section 4: Permits purchased on this site will be issued in the form of a printable license image. An authorization number will be issued for customers without access to a printer and will serve in lieu of a printed license.
17 18 19	Section 5: Any driver using an authorization number must carry a photo ID while driving the vehicle authorized by the permit.
20 21 22	Section 6: Applicants must have proof on insurance on the golf cart, must pass the safety exam, and submit a fee of \$15.00 to receive permit status.
23 24 25 26 27	Section 7: Owners may add additional drivers to the authorized permit. Additional drivers must be at least 12 years of age, must pass the on-line safety course and pay a separate permit fee. Drivers without a photo ID must have a printable license image in the authorized vehicle and must be accompanied by a licensed driver.
28 29 30	Section 8: Driving a golf cart on public roads without a permit will carry the following fines: First offense- \$250, Second offense-\$500, Third+ offenses-\$1000.
31 32	Section 9: Permits expire every two years after issuance. Drivers/owners must reapply every two years.
33 34 35	Section 10: All records of permits and renewal will be maintained by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and the Kentucky Department of Transportation.
36	Section 11: This bill will go into effect in January of 2015.
