1 An act to institute a golf cart licensing system in Kentucky.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All golf cart owners will be required to have a permit to drive the vehicle on public roads.

6
7 Section 2: The Kentucky Department of Transportation will create an on-line permit agency site that will
8 handle all permit applications.

10 Section 3: A safety course/exam will be administered through this site for all golf cart owners/drivers seeking
11 permit status. Applicants must make a minimum of 80% on this test to pass and be eligible for permit status.

13 Section 4: Permits purchased on this site will be issued in the form of a printable license image. An
14 authorization number will be issued for customers without access to a printer and will serve in lieu of a
15 printed license.

17 Section 5: Any driver using an authorization number must carry a photo ID while driving the vehicle
18 authorized by the permit.

19
20 Section 6: Applicants must have proof on insurance on the golf cart, must pass the safety exam, and submit
21 a fee of \$15.00 to receive permit status.

23 Section 7: Owners may add additional drivers to the authorized permit. Additional drivers must be at least
24 12 years of age, must pass the on-line safety course and pay a separate permit fee. Drivers without a photo
25 ID must have a printable license image in the authorized vehicle and must be accompanied by a licensed
26 driver.

28 Section 8: Driving a golf cart on public roads without a permit will carry the following fines: First offense-
29 \$250, Second offense-\$500, Third+ offenses-\$1000.

31 Section 9: Permits expire every two years after issuance. Drivers/owners must reapply every two years.

33 Section 10: All records of permits and renewal will be maintained by the Department of Motor Vehicles
34 (DMV) and the Kentucky Department of Transportation.

36 Section 11: This bill will go into effect in January of 2015.
