An act to offer annual tax incentives for recycling.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Currently, Kentucky offers incentives for energy efficiency (i.e., solar, efficient product purchases). Our bill proposes to offer tax incentives for Kentucky citizens who choose to recycle.

Section 2: For Kentucky citizens who recycle, a \$500 deduction for single and \$1000 deduction for married or married filing jointly will be given on annual state income tax returns.

Section 3: Tax payers will be required to show proof of recycling in one of the following ways:

- A) Curb side recycling pick-up service for at least six (6) months of the taxable year
- B) Drop-off at a recycling center or scrap yard located in Kentucky no fewer than six (6) times in the taxable year.

Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Revenue will oversee the disbursement and legitimacy of tax incentives.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2014.
