1 An act to regulate the sale of shotgun ammunition through current background check requirements.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: Presently in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, everyday citizens can buy ammunition without a
6 background check. Our bill will require a customer to produce a record of a current background check before
7 purchasing shotgun ammunition.
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9 Section 2: A current background check will be defined as any background check issued no longer than 3
10 years prior to the date ammunition is being purchased.
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12 Section 3: The Kentucky State Police, who are authorized to regulate concealed deadly weapons according to
13 KRS 237.110, will enforce this law.
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15 Section 4: All offenses will be charged to the retailer:
16 • 1st Offense: \$250
17 • 2nd Offense: \$500
18 • 3rd Offense: \$750 and suspension of license to sell firearms and ammunition for minimum of 5
19 years.

21 Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2014.
