- 1 An act to require citizens to take a driver's class after three failed attempts for a driver's license.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill will require all Kentucky residents to take a mandatory driver's class after three failed
- 6 attempts to acquire a driver's license.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: The residents who have failed the driver's license test three times will be required to take a six-
- 9 hour course: a four-hour class session with a total of two hours of in-vehicle driving instruction.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: The class session of this course will consist of basic rules of the road and safety. The driving
- 12 session of this course will consist of practical application of the material learned in the class section of this
- 13 course.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: The cost of this mandatory course will be privately paid for by the individual resident, and the
- 16 exact price will be determined by each county's courthouse.
- 17
- 18 Section 5: Upon passage, this bill will become law on the beginning of Kentucky's fiscal year, July 1, 2014.
