1 An act to require all food service companies to label genetically modified organisms.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: Any food produce company with its goods containing Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs) is  
6 required to provide information on packaging that GMOs are included in the product.

7  
8 Section 2: GMOs will be included in the ingredients section on labels or wrappers of produce.

9  
10 Section 3: The reasoning for this law is that genetically modified organisms are medically known to weaken  
11 immune systems and bring harm to the environment.

12  
13 Section 4: 1st offense: \$1000 fine  
14 2nd offense: \$3,000 fine  
15 3rd offense: \$5,000 fine  
16 4th offense: A cut-off of distribution of goods in Kentucky until the company includes GMOs on  
17 labels of packages.

19 Section 5: The company itself would fund the changes that would be enacted on it by this bill. The cost for  
20 the company should be minor because it would just mean they change the print of their labels.

21  
22 Section 6: The Kentucky Health Department will enforce this bill.

23  
24 Section 7: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

25  
26 Section 8: This law will go into effect starting on July 1st, 2014.
