1           An act to require high school students to take a personal finance course before graduation.  
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3                           **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
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5   Section 1: This bill is to require high school students to take a personal finance course before they  
6           graduate from high school.  
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8   Section 2: The student counselor will be responsible for helping the students arrange the course into  
9           his/her class schedule.  
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11   Section 3: This course can be taken any of the four years of high school but is recommended in the  
12           Sophomore, Junior or Senior years.  
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14   Section 4: Depending on size of the school, the school may need to add teachers for this course as  
15           needed. The teacher needs to have a bachelor's degree in business.  
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17   Section 5: The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) will enforce this bill throughout Kentucky.  
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19   Section 6: A teacher's salary on average is \$49,000; however each teacher's salary differs.  
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21   Section 7: If this class is not taken before the student's graduation, the punishments will be as follows:  
22           1st offense: The student counselor will issue a warning to the student at the end of his/her  
23           junior year.  
24           2nd offense: The student will be forced to go to summer school or take an on-line course.  
25           Until this class is taken, the diploma will be withheld.  
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27   Section 8: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.  
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29   Section 9: This will go into effect starting the school year of 2015 - 2016, after passage and the signature  
30   of the Governor.
