1           An act to standardize the grading scale in the public schools in the Commonwealth of Kentucky  
2  
3                           **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: The bill will standardize the grading scale in all public schools in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.  
6  
7   Section 2: The grading scale will follow:  
8           A = 93 - 100  
9           B = 85 - 92  
10          C = 77 - 84  
11          D = 70 - 76  
12          F = 69 and below  
13  
14   Section 3: It will apply to the grades K-12 excluding private schools.  
15  
16   Section 4: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE).  
17  
18   Section 5: The bill will have no cost.  
19  
20   Section 6: Failure to abide by this law will result in:  
21           1. A warning will go to the school by the KDE.  
22           2. There will be a \$350 fine to the school from the KDE.  
23           3. If the school continues to not abide by the law, it will be fined \$600 monthly until the school  
24           complies with the law.  
25  
26   Section 7: All laws or parts of laws in relation of this bill is hereby repealed.  
27  
28   Section 8: This bill will go into effect the next school year after the passage and signature of the Governor.
