1 An act to require adults to pass a drug test once a year to receive government assistance such as food
2 stamps and welfare.
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: Assistance should be used by the ones that genuinely need the extra help. Those who use drugs
7 should not receive money from the government. By enacting a required drug test this can reduce the abuse
8 to the system.
9

10 Section 2: A drug test is the evaluation of a biological sample to determine if the person has been using
11 drugs or drugs in question.
12

13 Section 3: About 50% of people in the US use some form of government assistance - according to
14 Libertarian Mercatus Centre at George Mason University.
15

16 Section 4: The local government will hire a select few to run the drug testing system and drug addiction
17 classes. This will create new jobs and make it cheaper for the government to supply drug tests.

19 Section 5: Penalties:

- 20 • 1st Fail - wait a year until applying again, take a short series of classes
- 21 • 2nd Fail - wait a year until applying again, serve 40 hours of community service (Examples: Feeding
22 America, Helping Hand, Habitat for Humanity, ect...)
- 23 • 3rd Fail - You will not be allowed to apply. If drugs are illegal you will be sent to jail for a period of
24 time.

26 Section 6: This bill will be put into action on January 1, 2014.
