1 An act to mandate that secondary language(s) be taught to all students in grades K-12.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: A Foreign Language Curriculum will be provided for all students in the Commonwealth for grades
6 K-12.

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8 Section 2: This bill will mandate that ALL Kentucky schools will include and provide a foreign language
9 curriculum for each grade level K-12.

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11 Section 3: Kentucky schools will be required to adopt foreign language standards for grades K-12.

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13 Section 4: There are many computer/online programs on market that can be purchased for foreign language
14 instruction. One such program is called AVENTA.

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16 Section 5: The cost of such said program runs approximately \$58.00 per student.

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18 Section 6: The cost will strictly be for the purchase of the program. The classroom teacher will be
19 responsible monitoring student progress by the data supplied by the program the school is utilizing.

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21 Section 7: The use of such program will not require the hiring of new teachers with a degree in
22 Foreign/Second Language. The program allows classroom teachers to be facilitators, and the instruction and
23 assessment will come from the online program.

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25 Section 8: This bill will come into effect the 2014-2015 school year.
