1 An act to insure that all high school students in Kentucky complete a driver's education class.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section I: The purpose of this bill is to reduce death rates caused by teen accidents.
6
7 Section II: Statistics say that Kentucky is 15% higher than the national average in teen accidents.
8
9 Section III: Studies have also showed that that 56% of teenagers rely on their parents to learn how to drive,
10 since driver's education classes are not required by the state of Kentucky.
11
12 Section IV: The Kentucky Department of Education will send a supervisor annually to make sure the law is
13 enforced.

15 Section V: The Kentucky Department of Education will fund this bill, and will send a trained teacher down to
16 teach the class.

18 Section VI: If any high schools violate this law they will pay the following fines;
19 1st Offense: A \$1,500 fine
20 2nd Offense: A \$3,000 fine
21 3rd Offense: A \$5,000 fine

23 Section VII: All money collected from fines will be sent to the Kentucky Department of Education.

25 Section VIII: This bill will go into effect on August 1st, 2015 or start of the 2015- 2016 school year.
