1 An act to require anyone 18 years or younger seeking a driver's permit or license to be in school & have a  
2 grade of "C" or higher at the time of driving test.  
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
5

6 Section I: The purpose of this bill is to push students to do better in school and have more mature drivers on  
7 the road.  
8

9 Section II: In order to take driver's test you must be a student and have a grade average of "C" or higher if  
10 you are 18 years or younger.  
11

12 Section III: All students trying to obtain a driver's permit and/or license must present high school transcripts  
13 (C average or higher) at the time of testing.  
14

15 Section IV: Students can sign up or be put in a credit recovery program, tutoring, or the school will provide  
16 assistance, if the desired grades are not met when seeking a license or permit.  
17

18 Section V: When the student's average increases to a level of C or higher grades then the school will provide  
19 documentation and the student can apply or reapply for a driver's license or permit.  
20

21 Section VI: Exceptions for this rule would be the following:  
22 -Individuals who have graduated from high school before the age of 18  
23 -Individuals who have obtained a GED or equivalent  
24 -Individuals with hardships such as work or family obligations seeking a GED or equivalent  
25 Individuals will be required to have documentation to prove their case for the exceptions.  
26

27 Section VII: There will not be any funding required for this bill.  
28

29 Section VIII: This bill will go into effect the next calendar school year after the passage.
