3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Once a family is accepted into the welfare program, they may receive benefits for up to five
6 children.
7
8 Section 2: Welfare benefits can only be used for necessities such as medical, housing, and food assistance.
9
10 Section 3: Welfare cannot be used for personal expenses.

12 Section 4: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015.
