1 An act to require high school students to take a life-saving course before graduating.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: All Kentucky high school students must take a 3-week life-saving course before being eligible to
6 graduate.
7
8 Section 2: The course will include lessons for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), AED deployment,
9 Heimlich Maneuver and correct recovery position training.
10
11 Section 3: The lesson will be given by a highly trained medical professional (i.e., doctor, registered nurse,
12 EMT). The highly trained professional will be responsible for supervising the course in each Kentucky school
13 district.

15 Section 4: School districts will choose where the lessons will take place, including the time of year and the
16 class in which the lesson will take place.
17
18 Section 5: The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) will ensure that school districts are providing each
19 student with this course and are administering appropriate penalties.
20
21 Section 6: Funding will be provided by the KDE's Support Education Excellence in Kentucky (SEEK) fund.
22
23 Section 7: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2014.
