1 An act to enforce The Educational Life Skills Center for homeless people.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The Educational Life Skills Center (ELSC) would help give homeless people an education, a home,
6 and a brighter future. It will provide life skills services such as; balancing money, proper bathing, how to write
7 their name and simple sentences, crafts, etc.

9 Section 2: The center will be funded by increasing state taxes from 6% to 7%. This will allow the center to
10 gain around 4 million dollars. This will fund the building, staff, and materials needed. The taxes will be raised
11 in January 2014.

13 Section 3: The term of this bill will help homeless people get an education needed to place a job to lead to
14 owning their own place of residence.

16 Section 4: There will be four ELSC's in the state of Kentucky. Once million dollars will go to each center a
17 year. One will be placed in Louisville, Lexington, Owensboro, and Pikeville because they are the biggest cities
18 in Kentucky with large amounts of homeless residents.

20 Section 5: If we do not provide the essential skills for these people who do not have a home, job, or a source
21 of income they will eventually become very ill for not having their basic needs.
