Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

An act to provide a tax break to companies selling products not containing genetically modified organisms.

Section 1: Genetically Modified Organisms, GMO's, are currently banned in over sixty countries, including Japan and the UK but are legal in the United States. GMOS's are inserted in plants and animals that are consumed by humans in most foods in order to increase their size and production rate. GMO's are harmful to humans and animals by causing chronic wasting, organ damage, gastrointestinal and immune system disorders, accelerated aging, loss of fertility, or even stunted growth in children.

Section 2: This bill proposes that companies whose products are free of GMO's will receive a 5% tax break. This will encourage companies to discontinue using GMO's in their products. These products will be labeled with a circular label that easily identifies GMO free products for the consumer.

Section 3: The company will be responsible for the cost of appropriate testing which will be included in regular Health Department testing.

Section 4: This will go into effect on January 1st 2014.
